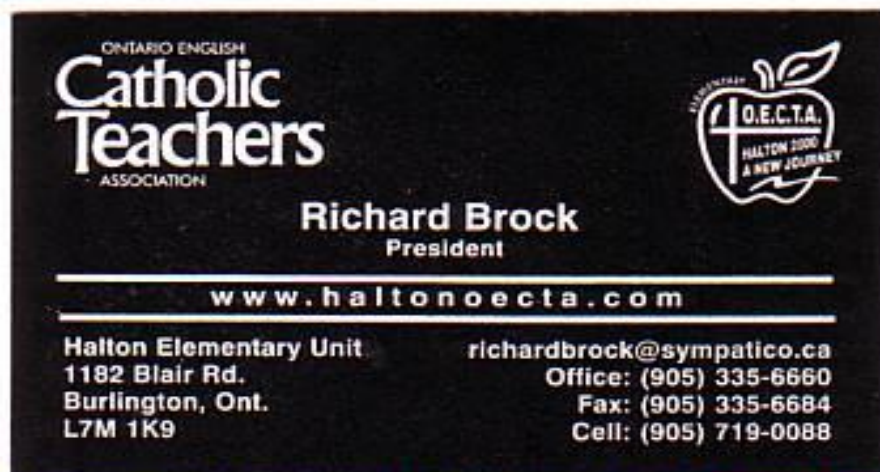

Good Afternoon,

At this time, there are a few reminders that I would like to bring to your attention:

- 1) If a principal schedules any activity during a teacher's planning time, it is the principals right to do so and the teacher must attend the scheduled activity. However, if that activity is not self directed by the teacher then the teacher may bank that amount of planning time.
- 2) Occasional teacher planning time as scheduled on the classroom teacher's timetable is redeployed to the occasional teacher during their scheduled planning time. While some occasional teachers offer the use of this time to cover other classes, principals cannot go to them to request that they cover a classroom to pay back planning time that has accumulated in the teacher planning time log. This is a violation of the Occasional Teacher Collective Agreement.
- 3) Kindergarten teachers can facilitate Parent –Teacher Interviews for all parent(s) /guardian(s) for Term 1 from January 30 –February 10, 2012. It is the Kindergarten teachers choice to utilize February 3rd to complete any teaching – learning related tasks to support student learning and / or conduct Parent – Teacher interviews.
- 4) Please remind teachers that teach the recorder as part of a music program that requesting a fee for the cost of the recorder is not in keeping with Policy II-47 Fees for Learning Materials, Programs and Curricular and Co-Curricular Activities.
