OTF offers members a subsidy for professional learning

Through the Ontario Teachers' Federation (OTF), OECTA members can apply for a subsidy of up to \$200 towards professional learning opportunities in the Arts to support the implementation of the revised Ontario Curriculum:

The Arts, Grades 1-8 and The Arts, Grades 9-12.

Application deadline is June 30. Subsidies are limited, so apply early.

The Professional Learning through the Arts subsidy applies to Additional Qualifications courses in dance, drama, music and visual arts; annual conferences offered by subject specific arts associations (CODE, OMEA, OSEA); arts related workshops, and professional learning offered by school boards.

Interested members must apply for the subsidy online and will receive immediate notification by return email that OTF has received their application. Subsidies will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis.
