Apply to be OTF-sponsored candidate for College election by November 21

OEFTA members who wish to be selected as OTF-sponsored candidates in the spring 2009 election of the Governing Council of the Ontario College of Teachers, have until **November 21** to submit their names to OEFTA for consideration.

The College of Teachers regulates and governs the teaching profession in Ontario. The Council is composed of 23 members of the College elected by their peers and 14 members of the public appointed by the provincial government.

OEFTA members are eligible to run for •

Two System Positions

1. English Catholic Elementary - a full-time classroom teacher in a Catholic elementary school.

2. English Catholic Secondary - a full-time classroom teacher in a Catholic secondary school.

• **12 Regional Positions** Northwest, Northeast, Southeast, Southcentral, Southwest, Central:

• Six (6) full-time positions - a full-time classroom teacher, residing in the region where he/she is seeking election.

• Six (6) full-time/part-time positions - a full-

time classroom teacher or a part-time teacher working at least 10 days in an academic year and reside in the region where he/she is seeking election.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Prepare

- brief curriculum vitae outlining teaching experience, local/provincial teacher organization or other relevant experience,
- two references, one from the local OEFTA unit
- a comment on four critical issues currently facing the College of Teachers
- a covering letter explaining why you wish to run for the Governing Council.
