## Online Voting for College Council underway, March 9 to April 14

All members in good standing of the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT) are eligible to vote in the election for the fifth College Council. This is your opportunity to shape the Council that will make decisions affecting the professional life of Ontario teachers over the next three years.

### HOW TO VOTE

1. You will need your OCT registration number. This number can be found on your OCT membership card, tax receipt from OCT, or you can search for your record on the public register on the OCT website at [www.oct.ca](http://www.oct.ca)
2. At [www.oct.ca](http://www.oct.ca) login to your Members'

3. Click on the eVote2009 button.
4. Click on Vote Here.



A ballot will appear containing the positions for which you are eligible to vote

5. Click on the button to the right of each candidate you choose.

2. Click Members in the top navigation bar
3. Click Create an Account
4. Fill in your College registration number and your identification information
5. Click Continue
6. Fill in your street address and email address and create a password
